

Beginning March 1, 2023, school breakfast and lunch will resume being offered at no cost to all students through the end of the school year 2022-23. One school breakfast and lunch meal per school day will be provided at no cost.

Students will still be charged for the following:
the purchase price of an additional meal
any a la carte items that are available for purchase, including milk
