### Citizens' Advisory Committees

The Board of Education endorses appropriate advisory committees for various district programs and activities. When it establishes a committee, the Board shall develop a charge (purpose) and provide guidelines for membership and delineate its responsibilities and authority. At the October Board meeting each year, the Board shall review existing advisory committees, membership, and committee goals for the year.
