Parent Involvement

The Board of Education believes that parents* should be knowledgeable about the education that the school district provides to enrolled students. Parent involvement in a child's education is a major factor in improving school effectiveness, the quality of education, and a child's academic success. In accordance with Public Act 97-290, Section 14, the Board recognizes that a student's education is a responsibility shared by the school and family. Therefore, it is the policy of the Board of Education to encourage ongoing communication and collaboration with parents to establish and maintain programs and practices that enhance parent involvement and reflect the specific needs of students and their families.

*Parent is defined as parent/legal guardian and/or other family members assuming responsibility for the student.
