If your child needs to take any medication at school, please do not send the medicine to PCS via backpack. All medications must be delivered by an adult to Mrs. Wyrstek, our school nurse. An order from the prescribing physician must also accompany medications and for EpiPens or inhalers, there must also be an action plan.

We have had four new cases of COVID-19 this week in grades one, three, and seven. Please be sure to conduct a home health check before your students come to school. Any student with a fever, vomiting, or diarrhea should stay home until they are at least 24 hours symptom-free. This is a protocol that has been in place for many years. For students exhibiting respiratory symptoms(cough, congestion, runny nose), please test them for COVID-19. If they test negative, be sure to send them to school wearing a face mask until their symptoms resolve.

Open House for students in grade PK-4 is scheduled on Wednesday, September 14, 2022, from 6:00-7:00 pm. In addition to those classroom teachers, Mrs. Klimaytis our Music teacher, Mrs. Peyton our Librarian, and Mrs. Lameiro our Art teacher will also be present that evening.
