

Dear Families,

The CT Commissioner of Education has sent us approval to choose to treat "snow days" as either remote learning days or as days to be made up later in the school year, for the duration of the 2020-2021 school year. In the event of a closure due to inclement weather, you will be notified if the day will be a remote learning day or if classes are cancelled. In most cases we will shift to remote learning, but if there are widespread power outages, it may be determined that all classes are cancelled. At this time, based on our current school calendar, we may have up to three cancellations without adding additional days in June.

Teachers are in the process of developing remote learning day plans that include scheduled live lessons and independent learning activities in the event that there are a few sporadic power outages. This schedule will mirror our current Wednesday remote learner day with morning classes. As these plans are completed, this information will be posted in your student's Google Classroom.
