

## Students

### Designated High School

In accordance with the provisions of the Connecticut General Statutes, the Pomfret Board of Education designates Woodstock Academy as the high school for Pomfret students. The Board will pay the full tuition and shall provide transportation for any child attending the designated high school.

Attendance at other than the designated school is allowed under the following conditions:

1. Enrollment in special programs such as Killingly High School Vocational Agriculture Program or Ellis Vocational Technical High School as well as special education programs recommended through P.P.T. The Pomfret Board of Education will provide transportation to these schools.
2. Requests for high school placements other than the designated high school must be submitted in writing to the Board, through the office of the Superintendent of Schools. Each request will be considered on an individual basis.
3. High School age students, who become residents of Pomfret after October 1<sup>st</sup> in any given year, will attend the Woodstock Academy for the balance of that year unless the student is accepted into the Ellis Vocational Technical High School or the Killingly High School Vocational Agricultural Program.
